It seems the attachments are larger than my bowl can handle. They do not turn correctly. Is that possible The motor sounds fine. Just too much of a load. It will have to be taken apart and the belt put back on. It will not start. I found the heat sink fuse in the motor was burning out. When the motor gets hot then turned off, no fan and the heat build up enough to melt the heat fuse. It would be an easy replacement if I could find where to get them. To find it on the motor, look at the wire going from one corner of the motor to another, but looks like it goes into the motor in between. Pull on that going into the motor to lift the heat fuse out. It would stick occasionally and then one day it wouldnt come off at all. The bowl would unlock and turn like it should but wouldnt lift off. After much time and effort I did manage to get it off and found that the splines on the shaft were scored. When I examined the receiver part, the lugs splines on it were worn allowing the shaft lugs splines to overlap the base lugs and thus becoming jammed. I cleaned everything completely and made a batch of bread dough and its stuck again. I think the base receiver needs replaced but it may be part of the transmission and maybe the whole thing needs replaced, I dont know. I sent an email and left a message with Bosch service and will post again when I hear from them. I have used the mixer for about 4 years and love it but this problem shouldnt happen I dont think.

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It seems like a design flaw to me. Some electric motors have optional voltage connections. If your motor has this feature, there will be a box or removable plate on the motor with 110 Volt and 220 Volt connections inside. If there is no such option available on the motor, you would also have to replace the motor with a 220 Volt version. Check the labeling on the speed control inside the mixer to be sure it is rated for 240 VAC, and check the power label by the power cord. Unless the electrical parts are all rated for 240 VAC or higher, conversion is not safe. Some products especially desktop computers have a recessed switch on the back that lets you select either 115 VAC or 230 VAC input power. If you have this on the mixer, all you have to do is use a small tool to push it to the other position. An alternative is to get a 230 VAC 115 VAC transformer or inverter rated for at least 800 VoltAmps and wire it with a 230 Volt plug on the primary side and a 115 Volt socket on the secondary side; then you can just plug in your unmodified mixer to this. I recommend including a power switch and a 4 Amp dual-element fuse or breaker on the primary side circuit; you don't want somebody burning up the transformer with a 1200 Watt microwave oven or griddle.
